

Rosie is nine years old and she often spends her time on London's red buses during the holidays. Her parents are both drivers and, when their shifts coincide, they have no choice but to take her with them through the streets of the city. On the day of the referendum, the parents take Rosie to St. James Park. Their mission is to find the famous squirrels that have a home there. But how come there is no sign of them? And how come, as the park warden tells her, the nests are empty and the pelicans have taken refuge on the lake island? The great adventure begins at the foot of a large oak tree. There, a secret world is revealed to Rosie's eyes, and she finds herself in the middle of a battle: foxes and rats, natives of the park, want to chase away the newcomers once and for all in order to reclaim their land, but squirrels, pelicans and parrots are ready to resist.

Through Rosie's eyes, one wonders: where is 'home' for each of us? What does it mean to belong to a country or a city, what does it mean to be "native" to a place? Do we not all, in some way, come from somewhere else? Perhaps then, what matters is how we manage to be together, with our differences that we carry around like a snail its shell, yet with the desire to share a country, a city, a park, a friendship.

Simonetta Agnello Hornby was born in Palermo in 1945. She has lived in London since 1972 and is an Italian and British citizen. After graduating in law from the University of Palermo, she practised as a lawyer by opening the law firm 'Hornby&Levy' in Brixton, specialising in family and children's law. She has taught child law in the Faculty of Social Sciences at the University of Leicester and was part-time President of the Special Educational Needs and Disability Tribunal for eight years. La Mennulara, her first novel, published by Feltrinelli in 2002 has been translated worldwide. Since then he has published several books including La zia Marchesa (Feltrinelli, 2004), Boccamurata (Feltrinelli, 2007), Vento scomposto (Feltrinelli, 2009), La monaca (Feltrinelli, 2010), Camera oscura (Skira, 2010), Il veleno dell'oleandro (Feltrinelli, 2013), Il male che si deve raccontare (with Marina Calloni; Feltrinelli, 2013), Via XX Settembre (Feltrinelli, 2013), Caffè amaro (Feltrinelli, 2016), Nessuno può volare (Feltrinelli, 2017). He has also published highly successful cookery-related books with a strong narrative component: *Un filo d'olio* (Sellerio, 2011), *La cucina del buon gusto* (with Maria Rosario Lazzati; Feltrinelli, 2012), *La pecora di Pasqua* (with Chiara Agnello; Slow Food, 2012) and *Il pranzo di Mosè* (Giunti, 2014).

He also published *La mia Londra* (Giunti, 2014), a personalised guide/memoir of London and the children's story *Rosie and the Squirrels of St. James* (with George Hornby; Giunti, 2018). All his books have been best sellers and have sold more than a million copies in Italy. On 2 June 2016, the President of the Republic honoured her with the Order of the Star of Italy in the rank of Grand Officer. Her latest book, *Era un bravo ragazzo* (Mondadori, 2023), is set in Sicily and tells a family affair, a mirror of society in the 1980s.


Because the questions "are everywhere, scattered like confetti after a carnival banquet. Recognize them, before science, leads to amazement, and this makes our world a really interesting place".

Rami Elhanan is Israeli and lost his 13-year-old daughter Smadar, killed in the centre of Jerusalem by two Hamas suicide bombers while shopping with friends. Bassam Aramin is Palestinian and his ten-year-old daughter Abir was shot dead outside school by a hard rubber bullet fired by a young Israeli soldier

Rami and Bassam come from two tragically opposite cultures, growing up in contexts marked by hatred and misunderstanding. The loss of their daughters represents a turning point: Rami discovers suffering on the other side of the wall, while Bassam, scarred by brutal imprisonment, embarks on a path towards non-violence.

The two men, united by pain, meet and become 'brothers' in a difficult but necessary common ground. They are part of the Parents Circle, an intercultural group of Israeli and Palestinian parents who, despite their pain, seek reconciliation through a path of dialogue and mutual understanding.

Two fathers is the true story of two men, and two families, special that with great effort, every day, overcome the pressures of prejudice and the temptation of revenge to bring everywhere a message of reconciliation, the only chance to free the two peoples from the hatred that corrodes them. Thanks to the collaboration offered by the protagonists, and their enthusiastic commitment to contribute to the authenticity of our project of story, we are sure that the stories of the two fathers will be a valuable tool of knowledge and inspiration, as never needed today, and as we see, even more in the days to come.

### **PROJECT GUIDELINES:**

**STRUCTURE:** The voice narrating is that of the two daughters who alternate starting from a few moments before their death. The story continues to give voice to the lives of their fathers at their age, until today. The text closes with a symbolic act of sisterhood between the girls, to seal the fact that these two brave families, these two fathers, as these two peoples, are brothers.

### Chapter 1

Jerusalem, 1997. My name is Smadar, I am Israeli and I am 13 years old. That morning I did not have to go to babysit. I was free, finally. I called my friends to take a walk in the city. I wanted to buy some books and then I would go to sign up for a jazz dance course. My father told me not to be late and my mother, as usual, to be careful. I took the white headphones, the player with Sinead O'Connor's songs and went out. The day was bright, we laughed a lot. At one point the darkness. [...]

### Chapter 2

At my age, my father Rami Elhanan was attending school. He knew all about the Holocaust and swore that he would never go to Germany. The other subjects did not interest him very much. He preferred to make a fool and play jokes on teachers. In fact, they expelled him. [... ]

### Chapter 3

Anata, 2007. I am Abir, a Palestinian who just turned 10. I love school. That morning I was also left before home to arrive on time. At halftime I went out with a friend and my older sister Areen to buy some candy. I'm crazy about it. I went into the shop, bought two candy bracelets and left. I gave one to my sister and put the other back in the folder. Turned the corner I felt a bang and then the dark. [...]

### Chapter 4

As a child my father, Bassam Aramin, lived in a cave outside the city of Hebron. Yes, really, a fully furnished cave. He was a good kid at school, but he was more interested in making the Israeli soldiers angry: with his friends he hoisted the Palestinian flag and waited for them to come and pull it down and throw stones at him. With the brothers, they prepared stones carefully. They colored them red, green, white and black. They ordered them well in the caves and imagined plans of attack. [...]

### Chapter 5

When he was 18, my father Rami went to the military service: he thought it would be a walk in the park. Everyone did it. If you didn't do it, you were different, a strange one, and he didn't even think about isolating himself. He never confessed to me but I think he had no desire to leave the comforts of home and the kitchen of grandmother. It was always a good fork. [...]

#### Chapter 6

My father Bassam was 17 when he and his friends found grenades in a cave and used them in an attack. That time it didn't go well and my father was arrested by Israeli soldiers and taken to Beersheba, the prison in Hebron. [...]

#### Chapter 7

When he came back from the Yom Kippur war, my father Rami had long hair. He was exhausted. It was 1973 and he wanted to dive into life. He started working as a graphic designer and met Nurit, my mother. [...]

### Chapter 8

After the first three years in prison, my father Bassam had become a leader and started studying. He had set a tight schedule: lessons in English, Hebrew, Arab history, Israeli law, the fall of the Ottoman Empire, history of

the Zionist movement, pre-Islamic poetry, geography of the Middle East. << Know your enemy, know yourself>> had become his motto. One evening while enjoying a documentary about the Holocaust, something unexpected happened. He would have liked to continue to applaud, but felt like a punch in the stomach. He began to wonder why none of them had reacted. Something inside him had broken. It was then that in his readings came had broken. It was then that in his readings came Martin Luther King and Ghandi. [...]

#### Chapter 9

Rami and my mother Nurit got married in a hurry, crazy with love and passion. The work was going well. All the posters of Jerusalem came from my father's pen. And among the various creations we children also arrived: Elik, Guy, Yigal and I. My father started to relax, earn more and gain more. Wars didn't touch him. Even if he was part of it. He was only interested in life in his bubble. << How would we Israelis survive without the Palestinians? Who would repair our refrigerators on Saturday, the day of Shabbat, rest? >> said. Happy years. [...]

### Chapter 10

In 1992 my father Bassam was finally released. He was 24 years old and had never held a girl's hand. When my mother's grandmother, her sisters, brothers and cousins came into the house, they were all lined up in the room. My grandfather was waiting for him in his room.

<< Does it bother you if I smoke? >> My mother also smoked, but the hookah was only when my grandfather did not see it. From a stereo came out the music of Abu Arab. They married thirty-four days later, because my father was in a hurry to resume his frozen life. My older brother was called Araab, like the singer but with two "a". I, Abir Aramin, came later, in 1997. [...]

#### Chapter 11

In that same year I died.

I was walking down Ben Yehuda Street and, in my headphones, went Nothing Compares 2 U. [...]

#### Chapter 12

The life of my family in Anata and the Palestinians in general was not a walk in the park. One of the things that my father Bassam hated most were, and are, the checkpoints. I tried not to think too much about bad things: I went to school, loved math and dreamed of being an engineer. << When it is my turn - I said - then I will change *things>>*. [...]

### Chapter 13

That attack not only killed me, but also the peace of my family. I was worried about my brothers in those days. For my father Rami, swollen with hatred and wonder. At first my mother held on. For her it was always the fault of the government and the Occupation. Not of those who blew themselves up behind my back. He also kicked out Netanyahu who wanted to go and visit them at home during the days of mourning. Then it broke apart and went to London with my little brother. I'd like to go back and put everything back together. Start from the day I was born, from the hospital of Hadassah in Jerusalem. [...]

#### Chapter 14

In that hospital I died. Twenty minutes from the Wall. After being stuck in an ambulance hours later. At the checkpoint it works like this. No order is passed. And the order never arrived. My father was in the ambulance with me. He held my hand. At my bedside, in the room, there were all the Israeli friends and the Palestinian ones. There was even the former part-time guard from Hebron prison. Above all, there was your father Rami. Good, because I thought my heart could be broken. [...]

### Chapter 15

My father Rami wanted to be alone at first. His bubble had exploded in the worst way. A year after my death, in 1998, she met a man named Yitzhak Frankenthal. He too had lost his son Arik, a few years earlier. But instead

of cursing Hamas and the whole universe, he had founded an association of Israelis and Palestinians, of parents, but also of brothers, cousins, sisters, grandparents who had suffered as he did. He called it the Parents Circle. My father was very angry with Frankenthal at first, because he said that he took his pain for granted, then one evening he agreed to participate. But only once, it was said. [...]

### Chapter 16

My father Bassam wakes up every morning at dawn. Since my room is empty, he needs to go out early. He goes to the mosque before prayers, wants silence. He has trouble waking up. Like your father Rami ten years ago, he feels lost. One day he called your father and said: << I come to the Parents Circle, I need it>>. He seeks peace, but he wants justice. He decided to denounce the Israeli government for my death. [...]

### Chapter 17

My father Rami says that your accent is funny, you know Abir? But you can't go a day without seeing him and chatting with him. They have left part of their work and together they travel the world to talk about peace. They never leave each other, and if they do not see each other, they can call each other on the phone. << It makes us feel better>> say. [...]

### Chapter 18

Our brothers are together on a stage to embrace and talk about forgiveness, reconciliation. Who would have thought about it. [... ]

#### Chapter 19

Today is a difficult day. Today is 7 October 2024. [...]



### **Index of Lives:**

- 1) Greta Thunberg 15 year-old Swedish political activist working to stop global warming and climate change, *Woman of the year* in Sweden, 2019. In August 2018, she became a prominent figure for starting the first school strike for climate outside the Swedish parliament building. In November 2018, she spoke at TEDxStockholm, in December she addressed the United Nations Climate Change Conference and in January 2019 she was invited to talk to the World Economic Forum at Dayos.
- **2) Pierre Rabhi** Farmer, writer and philosopher of Algerian origin, he is known as the French Gandhi. He was born in an Algerian oasis and then moved to France, where he began questioning modern values and pace of



life, in the name of a "happy sobriety". He fights for a society more respectful toward men, women and earth: he is the pioneers of agroecology and is founder of *Colibris* movement, he worked for UN's against deforestation in Africa.

- 3) Wangari Maathai An activist and the founder of the Green Belt Movement in 1977, she has been the first African woman to receive a degree in biology from the University of Pittsburgh. She advocated an awareness campaign in defense of nature and against deforestation. Her efforts were pivotal in the planting of over 51 million trees in Kenya. She has been the first African woman to receive the Nobel Peace Prize, for "her contribution to sustainable development, democracy and peace".
- 4) Jadav Payeng (*The forest man of India*) He was born in the indigenous Mising tribe of Assam, in northeastern India. He was 16 years old in 1979 when a flood devastated the family house, killing all the cattle. He has been planting trees ever since, and today that portion of sandy land has become a forest twice the size of Central Park, a natural reserve wildlife and people could return to.
- **5) Björk** (Björk Guðmundsdóttir) is an Icelandic singer, songwriter, composer, actress, record producer, and DJ. Over her four-decade career, she has developed an eclectic musical style that draws on a range of influences and genres spanning electronic, pop, experimental, classical, trip hop and avant-garde music. Outside her music career, Björk starred in the 2000 Lars von Trier film *Dancer in the Dark*, for which she won the Best Actress Award at the 2000 Cannes Film Festival, and was nominated for Academy Award for Best Original Song for "I've Seen It All". Björk has also been an advocate for environmental causes in her home country Iceland.
- 6) Dian Fossey She was an American zoologist who has devoted her life to the observation and study of gorillas, in order to protect them from poachers. She has spent most of her time with gorillas, first in the Congo and subsequently in the Volcanoes National Park in Rwanda. She could mimic their calls and actions, so as to let them get used to her presence. She is considered the world's leading authority on mountain gorillas, who died to protect them.
- 7) Vandana Shiva She was born in India and received her degree in quantum physics in Canada. Moving back to her country she realized how it had been devastated: forests had been replaced by monocultures, rivers by dams. She then made the decision of devoting herself to landscape safeguard and biodiversity. In the village of Ramgarh Navdania she founded Navdanya Seeds Bank and Farm a movement in defense of food sovereignty, seeds and the rights of small farmers throughout the world, especially women.
- **8) Sebastiao Salgado** Renowned photo-journalist who traveled the world from one end to the other. After a trip to Rwanda, where he witnessed first-hand the spectacle of human degradation, he became ill and decided to return home to Brazil, only to find out that the magnificent rainforests of his country had almost disappeared. He then decided to found, together with his wife, the Instituto Terra, a project to restore a degraded portion of rainforest in Minas Gerais, Brazil.
- **9) Bob Brown** An American doctor who moved to Tasmania in 1972, where he works as a doctor. He became a member of the United Tasmania Group, Australia's first green political party, and a restless activist for the environment. Together with doctor and runner **Nicole Anderson** he strives to protect Tarkine area, one of the last virgin areas of the Gondwana rainforest and an aboriginal archeological site from deforestation and mine industries soil exploitation.
- 10) Emma Watson Actress famous for her role of Hermione in the Harry Potter saga, she is also an environmentalist and a fashion designer. After a trip to Bangladesh in 2011 to investigate the human cost of fast fashion she decides to devote herself to sustainable fashion, creating her People Tree line. On the red

carpet Emma wears recycled plastic or second hand dresses, breaking the rigid and exclusive dress code of the stars. She supports ethical brands of fashion and cosmetics, and fights for gender equality and the emancipation of women.

- 11) Tiziano Guardini Young Italian fashion designer who creates fur coats from pine needles, sequin from mussel shells and clothing from licorice. His creations are known worldwide. He has been the winner of the Green Carpet Challenge Award, and is seen as a rising star of Italian cruelty-free fashion and luxury items. Tiziano is constantly doing research for his work, and resorts to environment-friendly denim fabrics, wineleather and soysilk. His dresses were exhibited by Geneva's UN seat and by V&A Museum.
- 12) Rigoberta Menchú Tum Guatemalan human rights activist, was awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace in 1992 for her efforts to achieve social justice for indigenous peoples and victims of government repression in her native country. She is also a Unesco ambassador. Born to a Quiché family, she first worked as an agricultural laborer and as a servant. Since the mid-1970s she has been active in organizing and protecting her community, threatened both by large landowners in search for land and by the repression by government forces. Forced into exile in Mexico, she organized the resistance against oppression in Guatemala and fought for the rights of native farmers.
- 13) Leonardo Di Caprio actor, environmentalist and philanthropist, *United Nations Messenger of Peace for Climate*. Since 2014 he is United Nations campaigner on climate change. He has been among the first Hollywood stars to drive a hybrid Toyota Prius (even to the Oscars), and his Ney York City apartment is located in an eco-friendly skyscraper. He bought an island in Belize to preserve mangroves from deforestation. Since 2010, when he donated to the WWF \$ 1 million to save tigers from extinction and preserve their habitat, he has been working tirelessly to attract interest on several causes in support of the environment.
- **14) Al Gore** Vice president in the administration of US President Bill Clinton in 1993. After his term as vice-president ended in 2001, Gore remained prominent as an author and environmental activist, whose work in climate change activism earned him (joint award with the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change) the Nobel Peace Prize in 2007.
- 15) Yvon Chouinard He is the founder of the clothing and gear company Patagonia, America's greatest supplier of climbing and mountaineering equipment. After realizing that his gear caused significant environmental damage he stopped production and created a company respectful of its workers, and oriented toward the creation of sustainable products, which expanded worldwide and has been donating 1 percent of its income to environmental organizations for the last thirsty years.
- **16) Ma Jun** Chinese journalist and environmentalist who has been fighting for the last twenty-five years against greenhouse gas emissions in his country, the world's first coal consumer and one of the major polluters on the planet. In 2006 he founded the nonprofit organization Ipe (Institute of Public & Environmental Affairs), and created the *Blue Map App* which allows users to post in real time about environmental damage or pollution, thus bringing the Chinese people together in a historic confrontation with the government. *Time Magazine* named him as one of the 100 most influential people in the world.





It's just a narrow, dark and damp street for now but it's a shot that brings her back to life.

Right above the basement, there is an apartment in which Lorenzo took shelter and there is the sailing shop of his uncle Roberto next door. Lorenzo is eighteen years old and comes from Rome.

He arrived in Portoferraio one day ago and he also has finished the high school's fourth year. He is a genius in mathematics but his true passion is computer science. He would work as a game designer. However now, all his life fells apart, darkened by a truth that he is not ready to accept yet.

His mother has a rare degenerative genetic disorder, Huntington disease, and the voluntary test that can be done only after the age of majority, confirmed that also Lorenzo will suffer

for this illness, condemning him to a degenerative progression. So this is why he took refuge to his uncle Roberto, where he will remain with the excuse of a summer job in his shop. The first meeting between the two teenagers is already a fight, and is an omen of a relationship rather than idyllic, but they will come to an agreement because Clelia received low grades in mathematics again and she must face the graduation the following year. On the other side Lorenzo needs to work a lot and think less and he also needs that little space in the basement where to park his bike.

From the disagreements on the respective musical tastes, to the cutting words, the relationship is born and leads them to recognize, support and fell in love with each other. Lorenzo shows her the beauty of crazy things we all do when we are 18. He can't accept the illness and he takes his anger out just when he is alone, writing emails which he will never send, full of rage, regrets and fears. With Clelia instead, he hides his darkness in a corner of the heart and pushes her to search for the excitement of youthfulness, knowing that it will die down too soon.

Until the beginning of September, when Lorenzo is forced to go back to Rome. They feel hopeless without each other but they don't have the courage to recognize their bond and face their weaknesses. So, it will begin a silent war of betrayals that will lead them to drift. Lorenzo gets back together with an ex girlfriend and tries to find the thrill of paragliding, swimming in the deep sea, the excitement of madness that made him alive. Clelia will sink into a self-destructive relationship with Damiano and she will refuse any approach and protection from her grandmother. Primo Levi was one of the greatest writers of the 20th century: a survivor of the Shoah, he powerfully recounted one of the darkest pages of history so that nothing would be forgotten. The story starts from the moment when Primo Levi, from a Jewish family and a chemistry graduate, chose to join the partisan struggle at the moment when the racial laws were promulgated. Primo was arrested in December 1943 by a fascist squad and, during interrogation in the barracks in Aosta, declared himself to be a Jew (rather than a partisan); he was thus taken to the sorting camp at Fossoli, near Modena. On 22 February 1944, Primo was forced to leave Fossoli and board the train bound for Poland. It was here that he began to think about writing, to recount the horror he witnessed. The experience in the camp of Auschwitz (February 1944-January 1945) is like a year in hell, and it is precisely in Auschwitz that Primo tries to recall the verses of the Canto di Ulisse. With his thoughts he begins to compose the poem *If This is a Man*. The awareness of trying to remain a 'man' despite the barbarity of the Nazis is consolidated in him.

The liberation from the lager and the long journey home inaugurates a new phase in his life, the double life of chemist and writer. These are the years in which he completes the drafting of *If This is a Man*, a testimony written 'with urgency'.

«In the silence of her office, on the first floor, she took a seat at her desk, placed her round glasses on top of a stack of books and then lit her first cigarette of the day. Enveloped in a cloud of blue smoke, she clutched that note in her hands as if it were

the most precious gift she had ever received in her entire life.

The words written to her by Jacques Jaujard, the director of the National Museums of France, left no doubt: 'I beg you, Mademoiselle Valland, to keep your place at the Jeu de Paume at all costs, to watch over the ERR men who have just taken up residence in our museum. Write everything down and report back to me daily. It is not just a question of saving France's artistic heritage, this time there is much more at stake: we must defend beauty - and with it the future of the world - from those who threaten to destroy it...'».

When the Germans occupied Paris in 1940, Rose Valland (1898-1980) was working in a voluntary capacity at the Jeu de Paume, a Parisian museum dedicated to foreign contemporary art. She was a woman who could apparently pass unnoticed, with her sober clothes, cropped hair and discreet manner; it was also thanks to this that - for a good four years - she managed to work as a spy for the French Resistance, making a decisive contribution to defending, and later recovering, the national artistic heritage stolen by the Nazis.

During the Second World War, the Jeu de Paume became the sorting centre for works of art stolen by the Nazis from French collectors, mainly of Jewish origin. Officially transferred to Germany for research purposes, the works were either destined for the private residences of Nazi hierarchs or directly for the large museum that Hitler dreamed of building in his hometown of Linz. Rose Valland, on the orders of the director of the National Museums of France Jacques Jaujard, in great secrecy and risking his life several times, documented the thefts carried out by the Germans, building up a veritable archive.


After the liberation of Paris and the end of the war, Rose Valland joined the Monuments Men, more than 300 men and women of different nationalities (intellectuals and artists recruited from among museum directors, librarians and art scholars) who recovered most of the masterpieces that the Nazis had looted and hidden in salt mines or in fairy-tale castles, such as Neuschwanstein in the mountains of Germany.

Once Rose Valland had completed her mission as 'Captain of Fine Arts', which took her around Europe for almost a decade, she returned to France where she won many prestigious awards, before gradually retiring to private life, together with her partner, the

Englishwoman Joyce Herr. He died alone in 1980 on the outskirts of Paris; only in recent years has his figure received the attention and honour it deserved.


"The whale is coming out pretty well. It's not the typical whale you see in cartoons, with a giant Godzilla face and a tail shrinking to the size of a pet goldfish. I drew her lean and flat, with lines across her belly. She has huge strong fins like those of a hundred-year-old turtle. She rarely goes up to the surface and sings when she's feeling lonely. This isn't in the drawing, but I imagined it anyway. And maybe you need a lot of things that you don't see, to portray the ones you do see."

Stella has a great passion for art, but also a deformed hand that makes her feel different. At home she doesn't feel understood, and at school she is object of scorn and derision. She only feels accepted in the world she draws in her notebook of marine creatures, that welcome her because of her <<fi>fin>>. Until a mysterious bench is installed in the park of her apartment building complex. Next to Stella, on the bench, some neighbors start to show up, all peculiar in their own way: Gerry, a man who always carries around an '80s portable stereo playing only singer-songwriter Franco Califano's compilations; Agatina, a retired chef who prepares and

freezes casseroles for a family that never comes to visit; and Emil, a teenager who always plays video games to avoid interacting with a father who won't listen to him.

Bruce Chatwin recounted the Walkabout in his "Songlines": "(...) It was believed that each totemic ancestor, on his journey across the country had spread a trail of words and musical notes along his footprints, and that these Dream tracks had remained on the ground as a 'way' of communication between the various distant tribes. A song was simultaneously both a map and a trasmitting aerial. (...) And a man during a *walkabout* always moved following a song path (...)."

We believe that the name Walkabout describes very well and encompasses the philosophy and the work spirit of our agency.
